## State of Rhode Island Monthly Meal and Beverage Tax Report FY 2016 Local 1.0 Percent Collections October 2015

In June 2010, the Rhode Island Department of Revenue began issuing a monthly report on the collection and distribution of the local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax. The report is meant to be descriptive and does not purport to project or assess the collection of the local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax. The report provides data by municipality on the month-to-month, year-over-year, and fiscal year-to-date over fiscal year-to-date collections. A discussion of the municipalities with the largest and smallest percentage and nominal changes in these three measures will be included in the body of the report.

#### **Analysis of Month-to-Month Collections**

On a statewide basis, October 2015 local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax collections totaled \$2.14 million or 3.6 percent less than the \$2.22 million collected in September 2015. The five communities with the largest percentage increase in local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax collections between October 2015 and September 2015 were: Hopkinton, 88.8 percent; Central Falls, 20.3 percent; Woonsocket, 19.8 percent; Lincoln, 19.3 percent; and Smithfield, 18.3 percent. The five communities with the largest percentage decrease in local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax collections between October 2015 and September 2015 were: Charlestown, -50.7 percent; Jamestown, -48.1 percent; Narragansett, -37.7 percent; Westerly, -31.9 percent; and Bristol, -27.6 percent.

The five communities with the largest nominal increase in local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax collections between October 2015 and September 2015 were: Providence, \$43,501; Lincoln, \$11,397; Smithfield, \$10,958; Woonsocket, \$7,976; and Cranston, \$7,051. The five communities with the largest nominal decrease in local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax collections between October 2015 and September 2015 were: Newport, \$(67,432); Westerly, \$(28,273); Narragansett, \$(24,101); Charlestown, \$(12,335); and Bristol, \$(12,234).

#### Analysis of Year-over-Year Collections by Month

On a statewide basis, October 2015 local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax collections totaled \$2.14 million or 8.1 percent more than the \$1.98 million collected in October 2014. The five communities with the largest percentage increase in local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax collections between October 2015 and October 2014 were: New Shoreham, 213.1 percent; Hopkinton; 45.5 percent; North Smithfield, 29.7 percent; Portsmouth, 26.7 percent; and Jamestown, 23.3 percent. The five communities with the largest percentage decrease in local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax collections between October 2015 and October 2014 were: Foster, -27.8 percent; Bristol, -18.5 percent; Burrillville, -7.6 percent; Coventry, -6.4 percent; and Cumberland, -5.7 percent.

The five communities with the largest nominal increase in local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax collections between October 2015 and October 2014 were: Providence, \$37,882; Newport, \$31,706; New Shoreham, \$17,662; Smithfield, \$13,034; and Middletown, \$11,705. The five communities with the largest nominal decrease in local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax collections between October 2015 and October 2014 were: Bristol, \$(7,274); Warwick, \$(4,410); Cumberland, \$(2,484); Coventry, \$(2,297); and Burrillville, \$(1,402).

#### Analysis of Fiscal Year-to-Date Collections through September

On a statewide basis, fiscal year-to-date October 2015 local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax collections totaled \$9.58 million or 7.3 percent more than the \$8.93 million collected in fiscal year-to-date October 2014. The five communities with the largest percentage increase in local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax collections between fiscal year-to-date October 2015 and fiscal year-to-date October 2014 were: North Smithfield, 33.0 percent; Little Compton, 20.3 percent; Portsmouth, 20.2 percent; East Greenwich, 19.0 percent; and New Shoreham, 18.2 percent. The four communities with the largest percentage decrease in local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax collections between fiscal year-to-date October 2015 and fiscal year-to-date October 2014 were: Burrillville, -4.1 percent, Lincoln, -3.1 percent; Glocester, -2.3 percent; and Coventry, -0.4 percent.

The five communities with the largest nominal increase in local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax collections between fiscal year-to-date October 2015 and fiscal year-to-date October 2014 were: Providence, \$86,214; Newport, \$74,095; New Shoreham, \$42,280; Middletown, \$41,774; and East Greenwich, \$39,072. The four communities with the largest nominal decrease in local 1.0 percent meal and beverage tax collections between fiscal year-to-date October 2015 and fiscal year-to-date October 2014 were: Lincoln, \$(8,365); Burrillville, \$(2,891); Glocester, \$(603); and Coventry, \$(586).
