# State of Rhode Island Monthly Local Hotel Report FY 2015 Local 1.0 Percent Collections March 2015

Beginning in June 2010, the Rhode Island Department of Revenue will issue a monthly report on the collection and distribution of the local 1.0 percent hotel tax. The report is meant to be descriptive and does not purport to project or assess the collection of the local 1.0 percent hotel tax. The report provides data by municipality on the month-to-month, year-over-year, and fiscal year-to-date-over-fiscal year-to-date collections. A discussion of the municipalities with the largest and smallest percentage and nominal changes in these three measures will be included in the body of the report.

#### **Analysis of Month-to-Month Collections**

On a statewide basis, March 2015 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections totaled \$166,480 or 17.9 percent more than the \$141,220 collected in February 2015. The five communities with the largest percentage increase in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between March 2015 and February 2015 were: East Greenwich, 295.7 percent; Johnston, 109.8 percent; Scituate, 86.6 percent; Portsmouth, 57.2 percent; and Middletown, 43.8 percent. The five communities with the largest percentage decrease in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between March 2015 and February 2015 were: Jamestown, -52.6 percent; Glocester, -34.4 percent; New Shoreham, -30.2 percent; North Smithfield, -22.0 percent; and Charlestown, -15.8 percent.

The five communities with the largest nominal increase in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between March 2015 and February 2015 were: Providence, \$13,461; Warwick, \$4,426; Middletown, \$3,097; West Warwick, \$1,187; and Smithfield, \$1,020. The five communities with the largest nominal decrease in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between March 2015 and February 2015: Newport, \$(2,041); New Shoreham, \$(197); Jamestown, \$(68); and Charlestown and Glocester, \$(25).

#### Analysis of Year-over-Year Collections by Month

On a statewide basis, March 2015 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections totaled \$166,480 or 4.0 percent more than the \$160,005 collected in March 2014. The five communities with the largest percentage increase in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between March 2015 and March 2014 were: West Warwick, 158.7 percent; Johnston, 108.0 percent; Cranston, 63.3 percent; Coventry, 56.2 percent; and West Greenwich, 28.1 percent. The five communities with the largest percentage decrease in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between March 2015 and March 2014 were: Little Compton, -100.0 percent; New Shoreham, -83.8 percent; Portsmouth, -52.3 percent; Glocester, -43.6 percent; and East Greenwich, -36.3 percent.

The five communities with the largest nominal increase in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between March 2015 and March 2014 were: Warwick, \$6,466; West Warwick, \$2,474; Middletown, \$1,343; Coventry, \$949; and Providence, \$831. The five communities with the largest nominal decrease in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between March 2015 and March 2014 were: Newport, \$(5,499); New Shoreham, \$(2,346); South Kingstown, \$(282); Portsmouth, \$(103); and Westerly \$(88).

#### Analysis of Fiscal Year-to-Date Collections through March

On a statewide basis, fiscal year-to-date March 2015 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections totaled \$2.55 million or 7.8 percent more than the \$2.37 million collected in fiscal year-to-date March 2014. The five communities with the largest percentage increase in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between fiscal year-to-date March 2015 and fiscal year-to-date March 2014 were: Portsmouth, 40.9 percent; Johnston, 37.4 percent; Scituate, 28.1 percent; Jamestown, 27.6 percent; and West Warwick, 23.9 percent. The five communities with the largest percentage decrease in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between fiscal year-to-date March 2015 and fiscal year-to-date March 2014 were: Little Compton, -91.3 percent; East Greenwich, -36.2 percent; Glocester, -25.6 percent; North Smithfield, -9.1 percent; and Foster, -7.9 percent.

The five communities with the largest nominal increase in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between fiscal year-to-date March 2015 and fiscal year-to-date March 2014 were: Newport, \$42,080; Providence, \$39,496; Warwick, \$31,732; Westerly, \$25,554; and Middletown, \$25,300. The five communities with the largest nominal decrease in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections between fiscal year-to-date March 2015 and fiscal year-to-date March 2014 were: New Shoreham, \$(4,718); Little Compton, \$(1,620); West Greenwich, \$(696); Pawtucket, \$(623); and Charlestown, \$(426).
