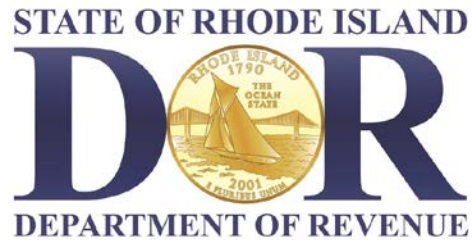

State of Rhode Island Monthly Local Hotel Tax Report
FY 2018 Local 1.0 Percent Collections October 2017

In June 2010, the Rhode Island Department of Revenue began issuing a monthly report on the collection and distribution of the local 1.0 percent hotel tax. The report is meant to be descriptive and does not purport to project or assess the collection of the local 1.0 percent hotel tax. The report provides data by municipality on the month-to-month, year-over-year, and fiscal year-to-date over fiscal year-to-date collections. A discussion of the municipalities with the largest and smallest percentage and nominal changes in these three measures will be included in the body of the report. It should be noted that early payments, late payments, and adjustments generated by hotel activity in prior months may be included in this report.

Expansion of the Local Hotel Tax Base to Vacation Rentals and Hosting Platforms

Effective July 1, 2015, the reselling of lodging by online travel companies, the unlicensed rental of accommodations via internet platforms and other media, and vacation home rentals became subject to the local 1.0 percent hotel tax. The Office of Revenue Analysis (ORA) has provided a breakdown of the local hotel tax base expansion components in the local hotel tax monthly and year-to-date collections by component tables. The City of Newport did not provide a breakdown of the local hotel tax base expansion components for July through September 2016. Thus, ORA was unable to include this information in the tables, and all collections from the City of Newport that were generated by the local 1.0 percent hotel tax during that period are listed under traditional hotels.

Analysis of Month-to-Month Collections

On a statewide basis, October 2017 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections totaled \$502,734, 13.1 percent or \$75,805 less than the \$578,539 collected for September 2017. October 2017 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections include \$107,912 of reported collections from the expansion of the local 1.0 percent hotel tax base. This compares to \$88,985 reported for September 2017. The five

communities with the largest percentage increases and decreases in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections on a month-to-month basis were:

Analysis of Year-over-Year Collections by Month

On a statewide basis, October 2017 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections totaled \$502,734, \$145,837 or 40.9 percent more than the \$356,897 collected in October 2016. October 2017 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections include \$107,912 from the expansion of the local 1.0 percent hotel tax base. This compares to \$6,645 reported in October 2016. The five communities with the largest percentage increases / decreases in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections for October 2017 versus October 2016 were:

Analysis of Fiscal Year-to-Date over Fiscal Year-to-Date Collections

On a statewide basis, year-to-date FY 2018 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections totaled \$2.60 million, \$408,221 or 18.6 percent more than the \$2.20 million collected in year-to-date FY 2017.

Year-to-date FY 2018 local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections include \$508,603 from the expansion of the local 1.0 percent hotel tax base. This compares to \$232,600 reported in year-to-date FY 2017. The five communities with the largest percentage increases / decreases in local 1.0 percent hotel tax collections for year-to-date FY 2018 versus year-to-date FY 2017 were:

If the total accumulated amount is less than \$5.00, the amount is carried-forward to the next month. For all municipalities, \$1,767.73 was carried-forward to November 2017.
