## State of Rhode Island Monthly Hotel Report FY 2013 1.0 Percent Local Collections June 2013

Beginning in June 2010, the Rhode Island Department of Revenue will issue a monthly report on the collection and distribution of the 1.0 percent local hotel tax. The report is meant to be descriptive and does not purport to project or assess the collection of the 1.0 percent local hotel tax. The report provides data by municipality on the month-to-month, year-over-year, and fiscal year-to-date collections. A discussion of the municipalities with the largest and smallest percentage and nominal changes in these three measures will be included in the body of the report.

#### **Analysis of Month-to-Month Collections**

On a statewide basis, the June 2013 local hotel tax collections totaled \$295,900 or 28.3 percent more than the \$230,579 collected in May 2013. The five communities with the largest percentage increase in local hotel tax collections between June 2013 and May 2013 were: New Shoreham, 136.6 percent; Portsmouth, 128.9 percent; Jamestown, 123.8 percent; Westerly, 97.6 percent; and Newport, 64.7 percent. The five communities with the largest percentage decrease in local hotel tax collections between June 2013 and May 2013 were: Johnston, -95.2 percent; Little Compton, -87.6 percent; Bristol, -80.5 percent; and Glocester and Smithfield, -57.5 percent.

The five communities with the largest nominal increase in local hotel tax collections between June 2013 and May 2013 were: Newport, \$26,601; Westerly, \$11,485; Middletown, \$9,892; New Shoreham, \$9,060; and Providence, \$7,599. The five communities with the largest nominal decrease in local hotel tax collections between June 2013 and May 2013: Smithfield, -\$4,884; Bristol, -\$1,476; Narragansett, -\$1,477; Johnston, -\$279; and Little Compton, -\$218.

#### Analysis of Year-over-Year Collections by Month

On a statewide basis, June 2013 local hotel tax collections totaled \$295,900 or 1.7 percent less

than the \$301,018 collected in June 2012. The five communities with the largest percentage increase in local hotel tax collections between June 2013 and June 2012 were: Coventry, 66.7 percent; Scituate, 47.6 percent; Portsmouth, 26.9 percent; Westerly, 21.9 percent; and Cranston, 15.0 percent. The five communities with the largest percentage decrease in local hotel tax collections between June 2013 and June 2012 were: Little Compton, -94.9 percent; Bristol, -78.3 percent; Narragansett, -62.2 percent; North Smithfield, -43.9 percent; and Smithfield, -29.1 percent.

The five communities with the largest nominal increase in local hotel tax collections between June 2013 and June 2012 were: Newport, \$7,691; Westerly, \$4,172; Coventry, \$1,551; New Shoreham, \$1,526; and Warwick, \$689. The five communities with the largest nominal decrease in local hotel tax collections between June 2013 and June 2012 were: Providence, -\$12,028; Middletown, -\$3,049; Narragansett, -\$2,635; Smithfield, -\$1,480; and Bristol, -\$1,288.

#### Analysis of Fiscal Year-to-Date Collections through June

On a statewide basis, fiscal year-to-date June 2013 local hotel tax collections totaled \$2.96 million or 5.3 percent more than the \$2.81 million collected in fiscal year-to-date June 2012. The five communities with the largest percentage increase in local hotel tax collections between fiscal year-to-date June 2013 and fiscal year-to-date June 2012 were: East Greenwich, 44.4 percent; North Smithfield, 24.5 percent; Little Compton, 18.5 percent; Woonsocket, 16.0 percent; and Westerly, 14.3 percent. The five communities with the largest percentage decrease in local hotel collections between fiscal year-to-date June 2013 and fiscal year-to-date June 2012 were: Foster, -32.6 percent; Scituate, -15.1 percent; Jamestown, -8.3 percent; Charlestown, -6.1 percent; and West Warwick, -3.8 percent.

The five communities with the largest nominal increase in local hotel tax collections between fiscal year-to-date June 2013 and fiscal year-to-date June 2012 were: Newport, \$45,603; Warwick, \$29,657; Providence, \$29,043; Westerly, \$20,438; and New Shoreham, \$12,846. The five communities with the largest nominal decrease in local hotel tax collections between fiscal year-to-date June 2013 and fiscal year-to-date June 2012 were: Middletown, -\$4,373; West Warwick, -\$1,477; Coventry, -\$966; Charlestown, -\$534; and Jamestown, -\$366.
